

## DAY 01 - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 5TH

# JACKSONVILLE / WASHINGTON DC / FRANKFURT, GERMANY

Depart Jacksonville to Washington DC. Change planes to Frankfurt.

# DAY 02 - TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6TH

# FRANKFURT/TEL AVIV/NETANYA

Arrive in Frankfurt, change planes to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival you will be met by your guide, and experience a tour of Old Joppa. Dinner and overnight in Netanya.

## DAY 03 - WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7TH

# TEL AVIV / CAESAREA / MT.CARMEL/ MEGIDDO / NAZARETH / TIBERIAS

Depart to Caesarea to visit the Crusader's Castle and restored Roman Amphitheatre from the time of Pilate and Paul's imprisonment. Continue to Mt. Carmel where Elijah had his contest with the prophets of Baal, and capture a magnificent view of the Jezreel Valley. Visit Megiddo, the chariot city of Solomon to see the excavations and Canaanite Temple. In Nazareth you visit the Church of the Annunciation then to the hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 04 - THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8TH

# BOAT RIDE / CAPERNAUM / MT. BEATITUDE / TSIPPORI /CANA / JORDAN RIVER / TIBERIAS

Boat ride from Tiberias to Capernaum to see an ancient synagogue and Peter's House which was later converted to a church. Visit Tabgha, site of the miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount is remembered. Proceed to Cana where Christ performed His first miracle and then on to Tsippori, a regional city at the time of Jesus, to see the mosaic floors. Travel to the Jordan River for those who wish to be baptized. Return to the hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

# DAY 05 - FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 9TH

# JERASH / MT. NEBO / AMMAN

Transfer to King Hussein Bridge and cross into Jordan. Depart to Jerash, the "CITY OF DECAPOLIS", known as the Pompeii of the East


for is extraordinary state of preservation, and along the way cross River Jabbock where Jacob wrestled with the angel, and changed his name from Jacob to Israel. View the mountains of Gilead and continue to Jerash, one of the largest and most preserved Roman cities, and where Christ cast the demons. As you approach the city, visitors are greeted by the imposing triple - arched gateway, built to honor the Emperor Hadrian's arrival at Jerash in A.D. 129. Visit the Byzantine churches, the Roman Amphitheatre, and the Street of Columns, where the Chariots raced. It is believed that Paul traveled through this city on his way to Damascus. Stop at Mt. Nebo; see the Tomb of Moses and where he stood and viewed the Promised Land. Dinner and overnight in Amman.

# DAY 06 – SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10TH PETRA

Today you will travel to Petra, correctly called the "eighth wonder of the world." This entire city of rose-colored temples and Amphitheatre is carved from the multi-hued rock cliffs which surround its hidden valley. From this city came the family of Herod the Great, who slaughtered the infants of Bethlehem. You enter the city through a narrow passage, surrounded by colorful and beautiful 300ft. cliffs. At the end of the Siq, you will see the impressive Treasury, hewed out of the solid rock from the side of the mountain, which is about 140 feet high and 90 feet wide. See the Amphitheatre, city center, and the Monastery. Dinner and overnight in Petra,

# DAY 07- SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 11TH

JERICHO / QUMRAN / MASADA / JERUSALEM Depart to Allenby Bridge, and cross into Israel. Stop at and tour Jericho which will include the excavations of the oldest city in the world. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, the last stronghold of Jewish resistance to the Romans. Take the cable car up to the site to see Herod's palaces and the baths. Continue to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Before ending the day we will stop at the Dead Sea where you can explore or take

# DAY 08 - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12TH

JERUSALEM / OLD CITY / TEMPLE AREA
Enter the Old City and visit the Western Wall
and Temple area with the Al-Aqsa Mosque and
Dome of the Rock. See the Pool of Bethesda
where the angel ruffled the water and St.
Anne's Church, the traditional birthplace of
Jesus' mother. Visit the Shrine of the Book, the
museum storing the Dead Sea Scrolls. Visit the
Rabbinical Tunnel. Return to the hotel for dinner
and overnight.

# DAY 09 - TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13TH

# MOUNT OF OLIVES / GETHSEMANE / KIDRON VALLEY / BETHLEHEM

Drive to the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. See the place of Ascension, the Pater Noster Church, the Garden of Gethsemane, the Church of All Nations, and the Palm Sunday road. Drive down the Kidron Valley to see the Pool of Siloam, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Continue to Bethlehem to see the Church of the Nativity and the cavestable of Jesus' birth. While in Bethlehem visit the Sheppard's Cave, and return to the hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.
